Cameron Lee Green was born October 30, 1970, in Wainwright, AB, to Winston and Elaine Green. The first of four children, he was a quiet, happy child who grew up to be an "old soul" with a quick sense of humour, gentle disposition, and unconditional acceptance for everyone he met.

Cam graduated from Wainwright High School in 1988. He attended TWU where he completed a BA in Psychology in 1992. He loved his time at Trinity and made lifelong friends there. Shortly after graduation, he moved to Edmonton to work at Ellerslie Gift and Garden Centre while living with his friend Stan Schmidt. In September 1993, Cam moved to Jakarta, Indonesia, for nine months to teach English and science at a private school. He returned to Wainwright where he spent about four years ministering in the local church as a youth pastor and working with his friend Dean Wallgren on his farm. He loved it all.

Cam returned to Edmonton in 1998 to work as a roofer with his friend George Sanders. During this time, he also began to pick up shifts as a porter at the Royal Alexandra Hospital. He completed a chaplaincy course through Capital Health as well as numerous courses towards a MTS at Edmonton Baptist Seminary. In 2002-2003 Cam worked for his cousin Trevor at Bulldog Protective Coatings in Edmonton. He eventually started working full-time at the Royal Alex. His job required him to transport patients and provide care in a variety of ways. He was so much more at the hospital. With his caring heart for all and his background in psychology, Cam was a mentor, chaplain, psychologist, counsellor, friend, and listening ear to everyone he met.

Cam married Melissa Welch on May 23, 1999. They have two amazing boys, Garrett and Hudson, who are their pride and joy. Cam was a hands-on dad and was home every night to be with his family. In some of his final days on earth during conversations with loved ones, words were spoken of the pride everyone felt for the life he lived. Many people in his shoes would have regrets and would be wishing they spent more time with their wife, children, family, and dear friends. He had none of this regret. What a special man.

In June 2021, Cam was diagnosed with neuroendocrine cancer and graciously walked this road, never complaining or asking, "Why me?" On May 23, 2023, surrounded by family, Cam peacefully left this earth to be with his Lord and Saviour forever. For all of us who have known Cam, there is a deep, incredible loss. It is painful as we just want to hear his quiet wisdom, soft gentle voice, and loving response in all areas of life.

Cam is survived by his wife, Melissa, their children Garrett and Hudson, his mother, Elaine; his siblings and their families, Jennifer (Daniel), Logan, Carson, and Josiah; Ramona (Ranson), Mikayla (Taylor), Brooks, Brayden, Ariana, and Denaya; Kevin, Tyler, Taliah, and their mother Lisa, as well as his mother- and father-in-law, Betty and Lance Welch, brother-in-law, Corey Welch, and numerous extended family members who all loved him dearly.
