NEW LOCATION FOR 2018: GREENFIELD COMMUNITY CHURCH

The 2018 E.P. Wahl Lectures will focus on worship, tradition, and the Holy Trinity. Dr. Edith Humphrey will treat all three Persons together, showing how the Triune God invites us into His presence, approaching this by way of the Scriptures and the worship practices of believers in the first four centuries. We see tradition in Christian worship through Paul's letters, where the apostle speaks of what he has received concerning the Lord's Supper, and the comportment of men and women in worship (1 Cor 11).

With regard to the Holy Trinity, we glimpse early Christian tradition (in 1 Cor 8) in Paul's reformulation of the Shema (*Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord*), including the Father and Son together as our objects of worship, and his suggestion that the Holy Spirit, too, is to be worshipped (2 Cor. 3).

Presentation #1 – Worshipping the Triune God

A focus on the OBJECT of our worship—the Triune God Himself—who also inspires us (by the Holy Spirit), and so also remains the Agent or Subject of the action

Presentation #2 – Worshipping Together

A focus on the importance of corporate worship (which touches each person, but is not individualistic), as seen in the Scriptures and tradition

Presentation #3 – Worship, Past and Present

A focus on the various traditions that fed into early Christian worship (psalmody, synagogue, temple, Eucharist, reading the OT in light of Christ, teaching, as we can see them emerge in the Scriptures), and how those remain valuable today

Session #4 – Time to Engage!



ABOUT DR. EDITH M. HUMPHREY

Dr. Edith Humphrey is the William F. Orr Professor of New Testament at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary. A respected academic and theologian, Dr. Humphrey earned her BA at the University of Toronto and her PhD from McGill (where she won the Governor General's Gold Medal). Dr. Humphrey taught at numerous colleges and universities in Canada before moving to Pittsburgh. Ordained in the Salvation Army, she has also served as musical director and organist at an Anglican Church in Ottawa and worships with an Orthodox church in Pittsburgh.

Dr. Humphrey is the author of seven books, including *Scripture and Tradition: What the Bible Really Says* (Baker Academic, 2013) and *Grand Entrance: Worship on Earth as In Heaven* (Brazos, 2011).
